## BACKGROUND

All phases of plumbing, HVAC, and construction; both new and remodel, residential, commercial and light industrial. Duties included project management, systems design, and cost estimating. Supervised and participated in the complete construction of several custom homes and numerous remodels while Vice President of Casey, Inc. and owner of MKC Mechanical & Special Piping.

Mr. Casey has personally performed over 8000 residential, multi-unit, and commercial inspections.
